I Mary Elizabeth Perkins of the Parish of Saint Ann in the County of Middlesex and Island aforesaid, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, do hereby declare this to be my last Will and Testament

I direct that all my just debts and funeral expenses be fully paid and satisfied.

I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved son Henry Franklin Cyrus Perkins, his heirs and assigns forever, those portions of Bachelor's Hall called Stallion and Bettoes pastures, also one hundred acres of land adjoining Staddon Pen, Woodfield Pen, and also adjoining the land now in possession of Joseph Bailey, and that sold by Edward Johnson and Esther Johnson.

I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved son George Francis Perkins, his heirs and assigns forever, the remaining portion of that plantation known by the name of Bachelor's Hall with the dwelling house and all the appurtenances belonging thereto.

In case of his death before me, then the land, house and appurtenances thereto, bequeathed to my beloved son George Francis Perkins shall be shared and shared alike

among his children — Herbert Perkins, George Francis Perkins, Rosabel Perkins, Kenneth Perkins, Harold Perkins, Mary Jane Perkins, Wahlia Perkins, Gilda Perkins, Anna Perkins, Daisy Perkins, Francis Perkins, Nancy Perkins, Frederick Perkins, and every lawful child which may be born to my beloved son George Francis Perkins after date — to them and their heirs forever.

I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved son George Francis Perkins Executor of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this ~~thirtieth~~ <sup>thirtieth</sup> day of October in the year of our Lord, one thousand, nine hundred and eleven.
