I formally declare them to be null and void. I appoint Kenneth Perkins and Harold Perkins, two of my sons, to be joint Executors of this my last Will in connection with my two Properties "Cottage" and "Mt. Hermon" and declare that these Executors must show proper and full statements of all Income and Expenditure, to the other children. I specify that my wife, Rose Perkins, shall live on, and be supported by, these my two Properties herein mentioned, until her death. My son, Herbert Perkins must be allowed to keep two cows on my properties until his death. To my children Rosabelle, Kenneth, Harold, Mary McElshan (Married Name), Daisy, Lilla Lloyd (married name), Francis, Frederick, Nancy Levy (married name), Kennell, Jane, Drivill and bequeath my two properties herein mentioned, share and share alike and stipulate that none of these lands must be sold to anyone. My children herein benefited will enter into possession after all Debts on these properties have been paid.
