Charles S. Burrows, 100, of 211 Lafayette Road, died Saturday at Community-General Hospital after a short illness.

A native of Little Falls, Mr. Burrows came to Syracuse in 1907 to attend the Syracuse University School of Architecture where he graduated in 1911.

He married the late Amelia Smith Burrows in 1912. She died in 1974.

Mr. Burrows worked in real estate and insurance sales for many years. He retired from advertising sales at The Post-Standard in 1959.

Mr. Burrows was active for many years in the Kiwanis Club, Syracuse Chamber of Commerce, Syracuse Homebuilders and many other civic organizations. He was an avid sports fan and a great booster for Syracuse University football and basketball. He was a member of the SU Orangepack.

For many years, Mr. Burrows was corresponding secretary for Zeta Psi fraternity.

Surviving are a son, Fred S. Burrows; a daughter-in-law, Jane E. Burrows; two grandchildren, John L. Garafalo and Terri A. Garafalo; and several nieces and nephews.

Services will be at 1 p.m. Wednesday at the Welter-Price Funeral Home, the Rev. Russell Hall officiating. Burial will be in Oakwood Cemetery.
