FROM THE BLOOD ROYAL OF ENGLAND.



EDWARD III., KING OF ENGLAND, Earl of Chester 1320, Duke of Aquitaine, Count of Ponthieu and Montreuil, 1325; crowned at Westminster in his father's lifetime, 1 Feb., 1327; defeated the Scots at Halidon

Hill, 1333. In 1339 he assumed the style of "King of France and England, and Lord of Ireland," and quartered the arms of France in the first quarter; gained a great naval victory over the French off Sluys, 1340, and won the celebrated battle of Cressy 26 Aug., 1346; 17 Oct. following the Scots were defeated at Neville Cross, and King David II. taken prisoner to London, where he remained nearly 11 years. Instituted the Order of the Garter 1349. His son, the BLACK PRINCE, defeated the French at

the battle of Poitiers, 19 Sept., 1356, and brought King John prisoner to London, where he remained nearly five years (for further particulars, see *Royal Lineage, Foster's Peerage*). The King died at Sheen, Surrey, 11 June, 1377, having had issue; his descendant

TRYPHENA BLENNERHASSETT (3rd daughter of Capt. John Blennerhassett, of Castle Conway, "Black Jack," see page 593*b*) married (settlement dated 8 Jan., 1723) to Ulick FitzMaurice, of Duaghnafealy, co. Kerry (eldest son of Garrett FitzMaurice, see note *); made his will 10 Aug., 1738; had at least 4 sons and 2 daughters.

John FitzMaurice, of Lixnaw, and Harman FitzMaurice executors.

advanced guard at Quatre Bras, and wounded; Waterloo medal; born at Knockavillig, co. Kerry 24 June, 1793; died at Drayton Green, Middlesex, 24 Dec., 1865; married 3 Nov., 1824, Frances Maria, daughter of Rev. Henry Watkins, vicar of Silkstone, Yorkshire, and vicar of Beckingham, Notts., (see BOWER, Foster's *Yorkshire Collection*); she died 9 June, 1877, having had 2 sons and 6 daughters.
